

Class and Grading Procedures

1. Students will maintain a ring binder to record assignments, notes, TEKS/TAKS information, tests, and practice work. This ring binder will be brought to class everyday.

2. Students are to be in their seats ready to begin work when the tardy bell rings. Pencils should be sharpened before the tardy bell rings.

3. Students will be permitted to leave the room only when directed by the teacher, the office, or in an emergency.

4. Students are encouraged to correct all test papers. Remember making corrections is another step in the learning process.

5. A school-wide progress report will be sent home with each student three weeks into each six-weeks. This report should be signed by a parent and returned.

6. Grading: HOMEWORK= 25% and TESTS= 75%

a. All math work is to be done in pencil only.

b. If a student does not complete his/her work in class, the work must be completed at home and be ready for grading at the beginning of class the next day.

c. A variety of teaching methods will be utilized. Our time of learning will be characterized by working together to understand mathematical concepts. Activities and teacher modeling will give the students hands-on experience and an opportunity to observe, practice and apply the concepts that will be helpful in real-life situations.
