

## **Math Uno**

### **Materials:**

Uno Cards or a deck of cards with the tens and wild cards removed.

Paper

Pencil

### **Instructions:**

If playing with a regular deck, designate the Jacks as Reverse cards (when a Jack is played, the order of play reverses), the Queens as Skip cards (when a Queen is played, the next player in order is skipped) and the Kings as Wild cards (they may be any number).

Dealer shuffles and passes seven cards to each player.

Remainder of the deck is placed in the middle with the top card turned over to the side.

The first player must either play a matching number or matching color card. If playing with a regular deck, the player must match the suit. The player must then give the product of the two cards.

If a player does not have a playable card, the player must draw from the center pile until a playable card is drawn.

Play continues until a player has one card left. That player must yell "Uno" before another player yells, "Draw two." If he doesn't yell "Uno" in time, the player must draw two cards.

Once a player is out of cards the game is over. The remaining players then add up the score in their hands. Face cards are worth ten points. Players keep a running total, and the game ends when one player gets 100 points. The player who has the SMALLEST total wins.
